

## **SIGN RESTRICTIONS**

It is the desire of the Board of Elections office to make this election a pleasant experience for both the people who allow the use of the facilities used as polling places as well as the candidates.

Remember that no electioneering or political signs are allowed within 50 feet of the entrance of the polling place.

On election day, please be aware that a red taped line or sign will be placed at the 50 foot limit and that no electioneering can occur closer to the entrance than this red line. Please inform your workers of the above-mentioned item.

Please keep in mind that although our office cannot enforce the electioneering policies beyond the 50-foot limit, your cooperation regarding electioneering and signs is greatly appreciated.

Please find attached Senate Bill 1014 concerning the littering laws. If you have any further questions regarding restrictions on right of ways, power poles, NCDOT signs, please contact the appropriate agency.
