On the 3rd Friday of every month, beginning on August 16 from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m., the automation staff will offer basic computer assistance. Anyone with a question on Microsoft Office programs, the Internet, email, or other computer applications is invited to drop by for expert advice.

On the 3rd Wednesday of every month, beginning on August 21 from 3:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m., the automation staff will be on-hand to assist the public with e-Reader issues. Anyone with questions about downloading either the library's eBooks or eAudios, setting up an account for the library's digital collection, or other questions is invited to bring his device and stop by.

"We are committed to helping library users get the most out of the technology that they use," said Beverly Osborn, head of the Automation Department. "This will give them an opportunity to receive help on a more informal basis than they would receive in a traditional class."
