One-Stop Voting will be held in the Griffin Room of the Union County Public Library at 316 East Windsor Street in Monroe beginning on Thursday, Sept. 19 - Saturday, Oct. 5. One-Stop voting hours are Monday - Friday from 8:30 a.m. - 6 p.m. and Saturday, Oct. 5 from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Canvass Day will be held at 11 a.m. in the Board of Elections office in Monroe on Tuesday, Oct. 15, 2013.

Voter registration and changes of address for the Oct. 8, 2013 City of Monroe Municipal Election will close on Friday, Sept. 13, 2013.
