County Manager Helps Girl Scouts Earn Badges

March 4, 2014, Monroe, NC – County Manager Cindy Coto met with eight Girl Scouts from Troops 3204 and 2701 on Monday, March 3 at the Government Center in Monroe. The Girl Scouts also attended the Union County Board of Commissioners meeting that evening where they led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The county manager spoke to the girls about the importance of being an active and engaged resident of their community and careers in government.

During the Board's meeting, commissioners issued a proclamation that the week of March 12 is "Girl Scout Week" and marks the 102nd anniversary of Girl Scouts of the USA, founded by Juliette Gordon Low in 1912 in Savannah, Georgia.
