Online Public Feedback Requested for Comprehensive Transportation Plan Before April 30

April 21, 2014, Monroe, NC –Union County Government is seeking input from residents on the Union County 2025 Comprehensive Plan Update and Transportation Plan. The public is invited to visit www.unioncountyyonevoice.com before April 30, 2014 to tell officials what they think are the most important issues that will impact Union County over the next 20 years.

Community members are invited to provide feedback online about growth, land use and identify transportation improvement projects that will improve mobility for vehicles, bikes and pedestrians.

The goal of this planning effort is to create a Transportation Plan in concert with the update of the Land Use Plan element of the 2025 Comprehensive Plan for Union County, North Carolina.

The current 2025 Comprehensive Plan was adopted in October of 2010. Although the adoption date is somewhat recent, the planning process began in 2006 and much of the content is based on information available at that time. The Union County Commissioners formally recognized that the Land Use Plan component is dated and authorized an update to the plan.

The development of a county-wide Transportation Plan is an effort that was already funded and was about to begin. Such a plan does not currently exist in Union County, although there are numerous transportation planning documents for various areas of the county that are adopted or in draft form. The Transportation Plan will include the various municipalities within the county to create a county-wide plan.
