Most of Union County's water is drawn from the CATAWBA RIVER.

UCPW is constantly IMPROVING its water system to deliver water to a rapidly growing county. You may experience fluctuations in your water pressure as a result.

SEVERAL other factors that may affect your water pressure include water demand by all consumers, whether your home is on a hill or in a valley, and your proximity to a pumping station.

Installing a WATER PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE (PRV) will minimize fluctuations.

A PLUMBER can tell you if a PRV is needed at your home or business.

Water pressure fluctuations can expose weaknesses in your plumbing.
