Community Watch - A crime prevention program that involves citizens working with each other and law enforcement to reduce crime and victimization in the communities.

S.A.L.T. (Seniors and Law Enforcement Together) - An advisory group of older citizens who volunteer & work with law enforcement.

SRO - School Resource Officer is a certified law enforcement officer who is assigned full time to a middle and high schools. This officer investigates criminal violations that involve students as victims or suspects, and they serve as a role model & mentor while promoting school safety.

Explorers - Students from ages 14 to 20 are able to participate in Law Enforcement training as well as assist Officers with various programs such as Kid Care ID and Bicycle Safety.

Senior Day - Held each year on the fourth Tuesday of October whereby senior citizens of Union County come together to enjoy each others company and learn about issues facing seniors.

Project Life Saver—A program to assist those who suffer from brain injuries and disorders or who have a tendency to wander away from home or their caregivers. A small transmitter bracelet is placed on the client's wrist or ankle. This device enables the person to be tracked if they wander from the safety of their residence.


