- ELECTRONICS:** computers, laptops, printers, VCR's, cell phones, stereos, TV's, microwaves, vacuums, electronic games, anything with a electric motor, plug, or computer chip.
- TIRES** (off the rim) **BATTERIES** (lead-acid batteries) **USED MOTOR OIL & OIL FILTERS**
- PAPER SHREDDING SERVICE:** shred your personal & financial documents (limit 5 boxes)
