ONE-STOP VOTING BUFFER ZONES

The following is a list of Union County One-Stop Voting locations and a description of each buffer zone concerning Election Day electioneering. Buffer zones as designated by G.S. 163-166.4(a), county board of elections, shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet. The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with red tape and a sign labeled "No Campaigning Beyond this Point".

- Hemby Bridge VFD, 6628 Mill Grove Rd., Indian Trail, 28079 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Stallings VFD, 4616 Old Monroe, Indian Trail, NC 28079 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Mineral Springs VFD, 5804 Waxhaw Hwy, Monroe, NC 28112 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Union County Public Library (Griffin Room), 316 East Windsor St., Monroe NC 28112 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Wesley Chapel VFD Main, 315 Waxhaw Indian Trail Rd. South, Waxhaw 28173 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Wesley Chapel VFD, 8821 New Town Rd, Waxhaw 28173 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
- Wingate Community Center, 315 West Elm St, Wingate, NC 28174 -- 50 feet from entrance of polling place with a sign "No campaigning beyond this point". Use 2 inch red tape to define Buffer Zone.
