



Union County Social Media Policy User Guidelines

1. The purpose of this site is to present matters of public interest to Union County residents, businesses, visitors and other interested parties.
2. Once posted, the County reserves the right to delete submissions that contain vulgar or profane language, personal attacks of any kind, or content that promotes, fosters or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability, or sexual orientation. Any comments viewed as threatening, libelous, or harassing are prohibited and subject to deletion. Further, the County also reserves the right to delete comments that contain the following:
 - Spam, advertising or links to other sites
 - Content that is clearly not topically related
 - The promotion of illegal activity
 - Sexual content or links to sexual content
 - Promotions for any particular services, products, or political organizations
 - Copyrighted or trademarked material
 - Personal identifying information such as home addresses, phone numbers or personal email addresses
3. All comments posted on the County-managed social media sites may be open for public disclosure in accordance with the North Carolina Public Records Act, and may be retained on file.
4. Postings on social media sites do not serve as formal requests for service. Any citizen needing a response from the County should call or visit the appropriate department.
