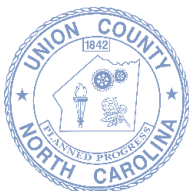

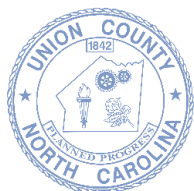
Re-inspection Fees; Additional inspection trips made necessary through the failure of any person, firm or corporation in charge of work, to give specific locations of work to be inspected, or to otherwise create conditions making such additional inspections or trips necessary, are hereby designed "Re-inspections." For each such "Re-inspection", the following fee schedule shall apply for each offense. This shall apply to all Inspections unless otherwise noted.

Initial Inspection	No Charge
Re-inspection Fee	\$75.00

A permit issued pursuant to G.S. 153-A-357 expires six months, or any lesser time fixed by ordinance of the county, after the date of issuance if the work authorized by the permit has not commenced. If after commencement the work is discontinued for a period of 12 months, the permit therefor immediately expires. No work authorized by a permit that has expired may thereafter be performed until a new permit has been secured. (G.S. 153A-358)

Therefore, the following fees will be charged for permits that are allowed to expire:

1. Permit expiring six months after issuance



- A. A new, second, permit will be issued within six months of the expiration date of the first permit for a fee of \$50.00.
 - B. Time that lapses beyond six months of the expiration date will require the full amount of fees to be charged.
2. Permit expiring after a year with no work being done
- A. A new, second, permit will be issued with the full amount of fees being charged.
