



Department Mission

The purpose of the Economic Development Program is to enhance the tax base and employment in the City of Monroe and the County by addressing economic development activities including the recruitment of new and retention of existing manufacturing, distribution and commercial office development.

Department Services Provided

The Board of County Commissioners adopted an Economic Development Incentive Grant Program to provide financial assistance as an incentive for expanding business investments in Union County. The proposed budget includes \$1,823,400 of grant payments. Of this amount, \$1,069,500 is recommended as a reserve. This amount reflects the committed grants that have not applied or fulfilled their obligations. If, and when, they apply, the additional tax dollars will be received to pay the incentives. Related NC Department of Commerce Economic Development Grant(s) in the amount of \$635,000 are also included in the FY 2020 budget.

In 2013, the City of Monroe and Union County established Monroe-Union County Economic Development as a joint countywide economic development program. The program encompasses economic development activities throughout the County including recruitment of new and retention of existing manufacturing, distribution and commercial office development. These activities will increase the tax base and employment in the city and county. To continue this partnership, the proposed budget includes \$416,000.
